Jerusalem Evangelical Outreach is a non-denominational ministry based in Jerusalem. Founded in 1989, JEO seeks to reach young Arabs in the Holy Land with the love of Christ.

Our projects include; media production and distribution, relief work, educational field trips and community development.

In 2024, JEO distributed over 10,000 bibles and christian resources in the Holy Land.

Social media is a key tool we use to share our faith. Our team creates videos in Arabic with a biblical message, and last year, 200,000 people watched a full gospel presentation online.

We follow up after the videos, answering questions and providing more information to guide people in their faith.

JEO is blessed to be in the land where many Bible stories happened. In 2024, JEO took 6 groups on biblical trips and made a video about Jesus healing the paralysed man from Mark 2 at the actual site in Capernaum. One young woman was so moved by the video she said, "I accept the Lord Jesus as my Savior and Healer."

In 2024, the team discipled 30 adults both online and in person. They also hosted small groups in addition to Connect groups, and provided spiritual support to Christians in Gaza through online discipleship.

Prayer Points

- For connect and discipleship groups to continue to flourish and expand.
- Provision and protection to ensure aid relief reaches the right people at the right time.





Our goal is to put the Gospel message to unreached people groups wherever they are! Many people are spiritually dead in our community. We want to help them know Jesus as the "Resurrection and the Life".

Thousands of families have dropped below the poverty line. With the shutdown of the borders in the West Bank and Gaza and the great decline in tourism throughout the Holy Land, many families are struggling to survive.



Jesus knew suffering, just as people are suffering now. Jesus also put all His faith in God the father and was victorious over death itself. This is why we were blessed to encourage people with the message of resurrection in these dark times.

Praise Points

- Easter Children's Outreach - we were able to hold 7 outreach events for around 400 children in different towns including Bethlehem and Jerusalem. The children learned that they don't have to do anything to earn God's love. They were invited to pray; it was a touching moment as most of the children participated.
- Blessed 260 needy families with food packages
- Shared in unreached places via social media. There was one man who said, "I would like to know more about your faith". We welcomed him and encouraged him to read the gospels in the New Testament to know more. We are following up with him and answering his questions about Jesus.



We encouraged a lady who came to pick up a food parcel for her family. She is divorced and takes care of her children and grandchildren, some of whom have health complications. We sat with her and had a long conversation about forgiveness and healing, a topic that she is struggling with. We prayed with her as she sobbed in tears. She was touched as she had been waiting for someone to talk to. She felt relieved as she opened her heart and shared her struggles over the years. We invited her to join our discipleship group alongside her grandchild and she accepted the invitation!

Prayer points

- Urgent Relief Appeal- It has been many months of war and most families now have no income. Others have had their businesses close down and employees have lost jobs. Many innocent people are suffering and going hungry.
- Provision so we can bless 2000 families with a food parcel in Jesus' name.
- Healing, for those suffering, protection of hearts and minds
- Faith, courage and open hearts to hope and healing

- JEO will bring comfort, teach & Minister through our children's and youth groups
- God's provision for those who are in need of food, shelter or medicine. We pray for more resources, especially medicine and food.
- Protection over our relief team and the churches in Gaza as they serve the needy in Jesus' name.
- We pray that the Lord will speak through our discipleship team as they provide spiritual counselling and direction at this difficult time.
- Peace and comfort for those sheltering in churches and living in cramped and challenging conditions. We pray that the Lord will protect their homes while they are away.
- Healing and comfort of sick believers in Gaza without proper medical care including one battling cancer.
