We continue the ministry to the local churches across Hungary and Slovakia that was first established by Gustav and Helena Pagac more than a decade ago. We continue to mentor and train church leaders, providing discipleship courses and materials, and help to strengthen

the local church to bring healing and wholeness to the local Roma people, ^{Tomas and Deborah Nagy} to families, and to raise up strong children's and youth ministries.

In 2024, Tomas and Deborah Nagy have taken over the leadership of the Újkígyós church and have seen amazing testimonies of God intervening, which has resulted in the growth of the church and many of their ministries including the children's and women's ministry. There remains significant work still to be done. Please continue to pray and support our churches and pastors across Hungary.

In 2025, the church will focus on community growth and mission, emphasising the following areas:

- Raising new leaders to facilitate ministry growth.

We had several guests in these last months, one was a group of prophets who shared, and we saw significant breakthrough. Some people who had drifted away from God, received personal prophecies that stirred them to recommit themselves fully to Jesus. This was an amazing answer to prayer and a miracle.

We visited the Tiszanána church in March. It was an amazing time serving with them. We gave them our used projector, so now they can project their worship songs and Bible verses for people to see.

Those who got baptised last year, are starting to get a passion to serve others and personal gifts of the Spirit are starting to manifest in the congregation. We are going quite deep in Bible studies every Tuesday and we usually have 10-15 people, having regular prayer meetings and are experiencing some breakthroughs in healing.

- Debby's uncle needs healing, he is in palliative care. He is a pastor of a small church in a village.
- We are also praying for people to have serious decisions towards God and receiving baptisms
