UPDATES FROM KENYA

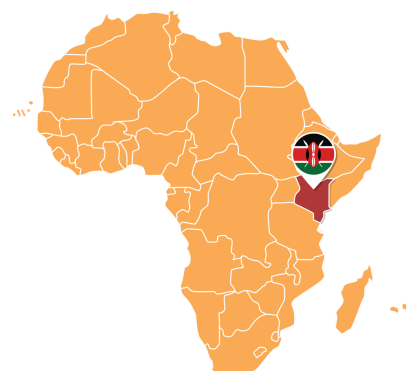
"Our cell groups have continued to bear fruit..We meet every week on Saturdays for four hours training these leaders. Our prayer is to see that these cell groups expand and reproduce more new ones but also to see everyone growing steadfastly in the Lord.

The Bible translation project has continued progressing well. We have so far managed to move to the book of Romans. The Books of Luke and Acts are already done. The challenges that we are facing are that some translators and a manager have left the organisation. Please pray for faithful translators who will willingly dedicate their time to the work.

One of the major challenges that we have in the community is early marriages. A lot of children in the community don't go to school or stop at lower primary level. They enter into marriage as early as twelve years old. As a church we have continued communication about the importance of education.

Prayer time together is every day from 3am to 6 am and has been upheld to keep us connected to God and to each other while aligning our vision and mission with the Lord. This doesn't matter whether I am at home or away. We have grown through this bible studies and sharpened our biblical knowledge. We are reminded of the early believers in Acts 2:42, as "They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer".

Let us also make daily time with God a priority, thanking him for his provision and mighty works. As the Live Connection team ministers in Africa this month, may the Spirit of God move powerfully in and through our prayers for them."

Praise Points 2023

Live Connection saw a huge milestone as we reached 230 Pastors Partnered.

The pastors are always asking for Bibles. This year we raised over \$12,500, with Bibles being sent to nearly all the Regional Leaders for their congregations. The Malawi ones were the most heartwarming, as many of the pastors had lost everything in the floods – a timely replacement.

We were able to send over \$2000 to Indonesia for their Goat appeal. This would give +/- 12 pastors 3 goats each as an income generating project as well as milk and meat for the family. The Annual Spring Appeal raised \$2500.
